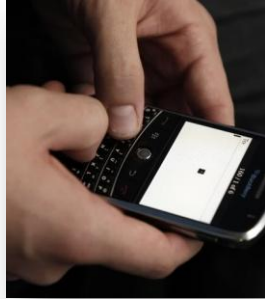
sometimes-fickle female brain. Here are some things that have sent me running:
